FLAG MARSHAL LEVY

All senior club members are required to provide a person to flag marshal for a full day of a club race event for the season. The flag marshal roster will be available to all members so there will be enough time to ensure your flag marshal will be available. Members who fulfil the flag roster will be refunded with the \$50 fee. Failure to provide a flag marshal will result in forfeit of the \$50 fee and suspension of club competition.

BUSY BEE LEVY

All senior club members are required to attend at least half a day per year at one busy bee. A busy bee roster will be available to all members so there will be enough time to ensure your availability to attend. Once busy bee is attended, you will be refunded with the \$50 fee. Failure to attend a busy bee will result in forfeit of the \$50 fee and suspension of club competition until busy bee is completed.

CLUB RULES

All riders must hold a current MWA licence. The main gate must be kept locked at all times. Members are not permitted to bring non-member riders to the track. Members shall not practice or compete if under the influence of alcohol, drugs or suffering any injury or illness that may impair performance, concentration or safe participation. Dumping of rubbish is prohibited, please take your old tyres, fuel cans & rubbish away with you. No dogs are permitted at the track. Members must respect the direction of all officials & other members as they have your best interests in mind.

PRACTICE RULES

No members will be issued with a key for practice unless that member has attended & passed an MWA officials accreditation course & obtained Operational Official Level 1 or higher.

During practice there must be one official to supervise a maximum of 5 riders. An official cannot be a rider.

Riders & officials must sign the 'sign on' sheet located at the track every time practice is under taken.

Practice is only permitted on gazetted non-competitive practice days. Practice times are 9.00am to 4.30pm daily & 9.00am to 6.00pm on Fridays.

Any incident requiring medical treatment must be reported to MWA immediately.

It is your responsibility to check the track for damage, debris or any danger to yourself or your machine prior to riding. Riding is permitted on the track only. Riders are not permitted to cut across the infield.

All riders must return to the pits via the pit return, the entrance to which is around the first bend, past the start/finish line, on the right hand side.

Before practicing, riders must check who is currently using the track. Seniors and juniors are not permitted to ride together. Two wheelers and quads are not permitted to ride together. Junior members must not be left unsupervised at the track.

All participants must wear helmets, clothing, gloves and other safety gear strictly in accordance with the Manual of Motorcycle Sports.

If you notice any damage to the track or fencing, you must report it to Dave Robertson on 0409 886 771 immediately.

Any breach of the rules will result in instant termination of membership.

DECLARATION

WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below).....(rider)
2. HEREBY AGREE with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1. (hereinafter collectively called "the organiser") that i am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity / meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed in Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

3. I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
 - (a) Motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport(whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach or official)at the meeting. I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - (i) That I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - (ii) That my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - (iii) That competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - (iv) That track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - (v) That organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of the meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/ or events;
 - (vi) That any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - (vii) That there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - (viii) That I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA.
 - (b) The persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1(hereinafter collectively called "the indemnities"), do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied; and

- (c) To the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- (d) I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

INDEMNITY AND RELEASE

- 4. **IN CONSIDERATION** of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting;
 - (a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND WILL KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the indemnitees and each of them in the following manner;
 - (i) That I participate in the Meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
 - (ii) That I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
 - (iii) That I indemnify and hold harmless the indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
 - (b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the indemnities from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arise as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- 5. The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- 6. A term of the release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

MEDICAL

- 7. I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my ability to participate. I accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.
- 8. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action.
- 9. Should I receive medical advice or treatment during the Event, including at the Medical Centre, I hereby consent to the relevant information being discussed to MA or my SCB (including without limitation the Chief Medical Officer) and to ensure my ongoing care and in the interest of public safety at the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my medical information held by MA, by contacting my SCB.

PRIVACY

- 10. I Hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by my SCB and MA in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by my SCB and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information by contacting my SCB or MA. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

- 11. I acknowledge and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdictions of MA and my SCB as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.
- 12. All participants are bound by the MA anti doping policy and thus understand they may be subjected to drug testing. Testing conducted by the Australian Sports Drug Testing Agency (ASDA) is in accordance with the Australian Sports Drug Agency Regulations 1999 (Cth). This involves the taking of a sample (any human biological fluid or tissue whether alive or otherwise, or any human breath) for the purpose of detecting the use of a Prohibited Drug or Doping Method. Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
